Council Member Dillon asked about work on Alber St in regards to the Stakes and paint, was advised the Nipsco is moving gas lines.


Council Member Salb asked about the utility work on Stitt Street towards St. Rd. 24, Street Superintendent Scott Richardson will look into the progress and cleanup.
