THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION, IF APPLICABLE, MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE SIGN PERMIT/IMPROVEMENT LOCATION PERMIT APPLICATION:

- 1. Note: One Sign Permit application is required for each sign to be installed.
- 2. A line or detailed drawing of the sign, including a front and side profile.
- 3. For building mounted signs (wall, projecting, roof, etc), an elevation showing:
 - a. All existing signs currently installed on the property
 - b. The proposed location of the sign on the structure
 - c. The length, width, depth, height, and overall size of the proposed sign, including any vertical clearances required
 - d. The distance, if any, that the sign projects off of the structure, including any projecting into any right of way
 - e. All property lines and dimensions
 - f. All streets, alleys, and other rights-of-way adjacent to the site
 - g. The location of all recorded easements
- 4. For freestanding signs (ground, pole, etc), a site plan showing:
 - a. All existing signs currently installed on the property
 - b. The proposed location of the sign on the property
 - c. The length, width, depth, height, and overall size of the proposed sign, including any vertical clearances required
 - d. The setback distance from the sign (at any point) to all property lines
 - e. All property lines and dimensions
 - f. All streets, alleys, and other rights-of-way adjacent to the site
 - g. The location of all recorded easements

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS WHICH MAY APPLY:

1. All ground signs and pole/freestanding signs (with less than 8 feet of vertical clearance) are prohibited from being located within any sight visibility triangle or corner vision clearance area. This restricted area is formed at the corner of a property where any two rights -of-way (including alleys) intersect. Please consult the Zoning Code for more information on this requirement.

IMPORTANT INSPECTION INFORMATION

1. Formal scheduled inspections are not required in conjunction with a Sign Permit.
