If the Special Event is to include any vehicles, pedestrians or other objects, hereinafter "participants", crossing a railroad right-of-way, or if the event is to occur within 150 feet of a railroad right-of-way, the event is not finally approved until:

(i) In the case of the event participants crossing the railroad right-of-way, the applicant provides evidence that the railroad has been advised of the time, location and nature of event participants that will be crossing the railroad tracks and submits a plan with the application as to what steps the applicant has or will take to prevent the possibility of a train colliding with participants; and

(ii) In the case of the event occurring within 150 feet of the railroad right-of-way, the applicant submits a plan with the application on how to minimize any event participants from crossing, blocking or otherwise being in the railroad right-of-way while attending or waiting to attend the Special Event, which plan, depending on the nature of the event, may or may not include notification to the railroad.

(iii) In all cases covered by this subparagraph, the applicant must also certify that the event will not include the use of any device that sounds similar to the warning bells, horns, or other audible devices commonly used by railroad companies to warn others of an approaching train.
