

RESOLUTION NO. 3, 2022

**BEING A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
ACCEPTING SALAMONE LANE TO THE CITY OF WABASH AND THE
DEDICATING SALAMONIE LANE FOR PUBLIC USAGE**

WHEREAS, D AND J RADABAUGH, INC., is the owner and developer of certain property now known as Chippewa Estates; and

WHEREAS, Chippewa Estates was originally platted in 1979 and included a street to be known as Salamonie Lane but said plat was not fully developed and construction of said street was not completed; and

WHEREAS, Chippewa Estates was re-platted in 2020, the re-platting was approved by Wabash City Plan Commission, and the construction of Salamone Lane was completed; and

WHEREAS, the re-platted Chippewa Estates was recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Wabash County, Indiana on the 16th day of October, 2020 as Record Number 2020R464762; and


WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Wabash City Street Department, Wabash, Indiana has inspected said street and determined it to have been constructed to city standards; and

WHEREAS, that portion of the re-platted Chippewa estates commonly known and referred to as Salamonie Lane located in Wabash County, Indiana was intended to be used by the public as a public street, and

WHEREAS, the real estate commonly known and referred to as Salamonie Lane, Wabash, Indiana has never been formally dedicated as such to the City of Wabash, Indiana as a public way:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Public Works and Safety for the City of Wabash, Indiana that Salamonie Lane as re-platted in 2020 and recorded as hereinabove set forth is hereby formally accepted and dedicated to the public as public street to be maintained by the City of Wabash and to be used as are all other streets within the City of Wabash, Indiana effective as of the date of this resolution.
